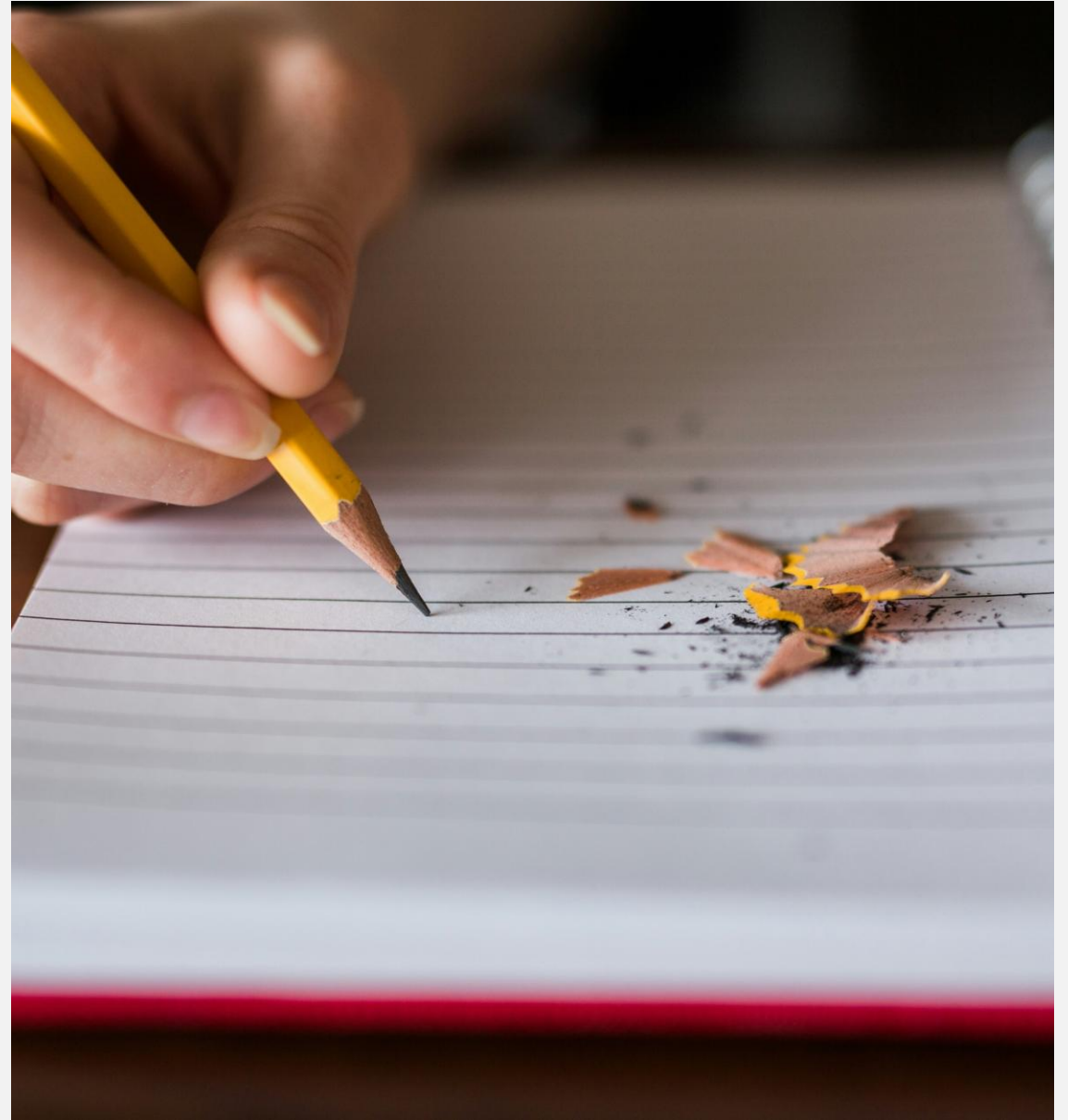

Comprehension

To improve comprehension, actively read and analyze the structure, themes, and vocabulary of texts. Summarizing paragraphs and answering questions helps develop this skill.



Grammar

Tense: Use consistent verb tenses that fit narrative.

Prepositions: Ensure correct use of prepositions that fit common collocations

Proofreading: Check for spelling mistakes, punctuation, capitalization, and sentence clarity.

Phrasal verbs: Use correct phrasal verbs for informal or conversational contexts



Word Formation

Practice converting words between different forms (noun, verb, adjective, adverb) and using prefixes/suffixes to change meanings.





Literary Devices

Simile – Compare two things using “like” or “as”

Metaphor – Imply direct comparison

Personification – Give human traits to non-human things

Symbolism:

Color symbolism, Animal symbolism, Object symbolism
