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

Grammar

Tense: Use consistent verb tenses that fit narrative.

Prepositions: Ensure correct use of prepositions that fit common collocations

Proofreading: Check for spelling mistakes, punctuation, capitalization, and sentence clarity.

Phrasal verbs: Use correct phrasal verbs for informal or

conversational contexts

Comprehension

To improve comprehension, actively read and analyze the structure, themes, and vocabulary of texts.
Summarizing paragraphs and answering questions helps develop this skill.


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
